Subject: Implementation of Changes to Regulation 184/97,

Teachers' Qualifications

Recent changes to Regulation 184/97, Teachers' Qualifications will have an impact on the availability of particular qualifications, including those identified in Schedules A and B as options in the program of professional education and those identified in Schedules A to E as additional basic qualifications and additional qualifications.

The College hopes that this memo and the attachment will provide helpful information about the implications of these changes both on the availability of qualifications and the delivery of the respective qualification courses.

Qualifications That are Being Discontinued

Qualifications being removed from Schedules A, C and E will not be awarded after August 31, 2008. Providers will only be able to offer these courses up to and including the summer session of 2008. Where courses have been accredited for a period beyond August 31, 2008, the end of the accreditation period, for all intents and purposes, will be August 31, 2008.

Where qualifications are being removed from Schedule D – three-session Additional Qualification courses – the qualifications will be phased out by August 31, 2012. The College expects that providers will not offer Part I of Schedule D courses after August 31, 2008. Part II and Specialist courses can be phased out at the discretion of the provider over the period 2008 to 2012. However, the last time the Specialist qualification course may be offered is the summer session of 2012. We would ask that you inform us in writing of how you intend to phase out your Schedule D offerings.

Providers whose Schedule D Part II and Specialist courses come up for accreditation during the phase-out period will need to submit an application to have the courses re-accredited. If approved, the accreditation period will be for a period up to three years but will not extend beyond August 31, 2012.

Please assure members who hold qualifications that are no longer being awarded that they continue to hold the qualifications they have earned and those qualifications will continue to appear on their teaching certificate.

Qualifications That are Being Renamed

A number of qualifications in the schedules are being renamed. In this case, the name of the qualification on a member's Certificate of Qualification will not change, but members who hold the current qualification are deemed to hold the new qualification. In the case of three-part courses that have been renamed, candidates who have completed the first part may enrol in the next course – Part II and/or Specialist – without completing the preceding newly named course.

Providers' courses that have been accredited with the current name will continue to be accredited for the specific time period identified in the accreditation decision. When a provider applies for re-accreditation, the provider will identify the course using the new name from the drop-down box in Accreditation Information Management System (AIMS).

New Qualifications

New qualifications have been added to the schedules. College staff are working diligently to have the new guidelines available through 2008 so that providers are able to seek accreditation for the new courses prior to offering them. The first time that accredited courses leading to the new qualifications may be offered is September 1, 2008.

For reporting purposes, the College is creating new course codes for the new qualifications that will be loaded onto Faculty Plus. Information about the new course codes and those that are being withdrawn from Faculty Plus will be sent to you in May.
